The Wayne Fox Lecture - Feb 2014




The February meeting was a very interesting and informative lecture by Wayne Fox. . Apparently Wayne arrived late but I arrived later so thanks to Stuart for his notes. Wayne produced 4 kings then demonstrated his Instant Cards to Box effect where he shuffles the pack and cards "all" instantly go inside the box.






He then performed what Stuart describes as "a nice little force" and a brilliant flick for card under hand and a flash finish of 4 of a kind



One in a Thousand. Wayne then asked a spectator to write a number between 1-1000 on a business card and produced a card with the same number from his wallet Knock out Prediction. A pack was divided between 4 spectators and shuffled. Spectators were asked to cut the deck and Wayne matched the chosen card.



Wayne advised those looking for residencies in restaurants how to get work. He suggested eating in the restaurant with a group of friends and performing, not too discreetly, for them. He also described how, in the past, he has got work by sneaking into events such as premieres pretending that he has been booked. Wayne then performed Any Card on the Table.. A spectator names a card, magician puts a card on the table eg QH and looks at deck while asking the spectator to name their card. The chosen card is cut to the bottom and switched with card on the table.



Next was Logical Black 8, an effect is performed where a black 8 is the chosen card. A black 8 ball is dropped loudly onto the table (Wayne recommended trying to use all the senses), a false transfers made and a smaller black 8 ball switched in.





Wayne then showed us his wonderful hold out. An elasticated strap with pockets of various sizes to fit his props. This can be used to vanish or produce coins, thumbtips etc.



Wayne closed with a clever effect . Secret Soldier, where a previously seen toy soldier is shown to be holding the chosen card. Wayne's lecture was entertaining and interesting and had something of interest for everyone.
