


**Simon closed with a magic square.**



**Sarah performed a pirate act with a variation of the skipping rope trick, a date prediction which went wrong and treasure production.**







**Theo performed a sealed envelope prediction, a card trick, a number prediction and a clever card fishing effect.**



**Marcus, playing the part of an Event Manager, asked Paul to help and gave out four printed cards with details of a venue, companion, menu and music for an event.**


**Those holding the cards were asked to select one item which matched a prediction.**
